Deuteronomy 11:14 *"He will give the rain for your land in its season, the early and late rain, that you may gather in your grain and your new wine and your oil".*

Hosea 6:3 *"So let us know, let us press on to know the LORD; His going forth as certain as the dawn; and He will come to us like the rain, like the spring rain watering the earth".*

Deuteronomy 32:2 *"Let my teaching drop as the rain, my speech distill as the dew, as the droplets on the fresh grass and as the showers on the herb".*
