

Our **GOAL of LIFE to LIVE** is first and foremost that *“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself”* Luke 10:27, Deut. 6:5. There are the maskers vs. the anti-maskers. There are the Vacciners vs. the never-Vacciners. The attacks are vicious, and the words are harsh on all sides of the arguments. Social media amongst many Christians has devolved to a new level of ugliness. Pastors have jumped into the mix, confusing their roles, thinking that they are doctors and scientists. This leads to confusion for many in the church. Some people ignore their doctors’ medical advice on theological grounds. Meanwhile, the world is looking in and thinking, ‘There go all those Christians again’ – laughing to themselves and writing the Church off as irrelevant. All the while, Satan is sitting back and laughing. Why? His greatest ally in keeping people from the truth of Jesus the Christ is an ineffective Church. When we are fighting each other, we are as ineffective as it gets.*

What a great story of what can happen when we trust God. Sadly, though, in these times the Church is not the one marching to battle. We are the ones fighting each other in the valley. So, when those who are anti-Church and anti-God prepare to battle against the Lord’s people on the issues of freedom of religion, freedom of speech, and gender issues, they find the Church already defeated – torn to pieces by one another”.

We must move forward at a set pace making decisions, actions, and observe reactions of interaction with others – toward observing effects. We grow through effects and even failures. The enemy will attack our forward motion with opposition. Moving backward is never an option. The prophetic purpose of God in our **LIFE** – is to first **LIVE** the **LIFE** He has for us. We must have patience to see the outcome of that process. We have to be led by the Spirit into a God ordained **LIFE**. He leads us from destiny to destiny to our final destiny or end of life. As Christians we need to continuously renew our minds in Bible study and prayer as well as focus on positive good things. Dwelling with worry on things that we cannot control and that’s probably ninety percent of what we worry about, we pull ourselves down with stress and resulting depression. Rom 12:2 says, *“And do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove that the Will of God is that which is good and acceptable and perfect”*. When our mind and heart are downcast the **Spirit of Heaviness** brings a heavy, oppressive feeling causing a darkness like a heavy burden or cloud to envelope

us. We begin to doubt our faith and Gods relationship and love for us. We want to isolate ourselves from others and then a loneliness followed by mental turmoil involving confusion, agitation, anxiety, depression, and fear set in. To kick off this suppression we must acknowledge that fear is not of God and remember 2 Tim 1:7 *“For God has not given us a **Spirit of Fear**, but of power and love and of a sound mind”*.

Our circumstances will always be in a state of “up and down” but keeping our mind on Jesus the Christ with thanksgiving in all circumstances we can shake the negative attacks of the mind, will, and emotions. The more we thank Him again and again and particularly for our salvation the more we release the stranglehold of selfness and let the sunshine in from the Son. That is what the world needs to see. When the world sees our love for one another, they will recognize that there is a better way to live than how they have been living. That is when we will be a light in this world. That is when we will be offering hope to the hopeless. That is when we will be taking those who are dead and showing them how they can find **LIFE**. That is when we will be keeping the main thing the main thing.
